



Arena Eventing Information

BE90 & BE 100 - Saturday 7th & Sunday 8th July 2018

- Competitors will jump a course of show jumps immediately followed by cross country fences and will finish with the last fence as a show jump, the Joker fence. The Joker fence must be jumped and will be approximately 10cm higher than the rest of the course. If you knock the Joker fence down you will incur 6 penalties.
- The optimum time will be based on a speed of 360mpm for 90cm class and 375mpm for 100cm class, as agreed with the course designer.

Competition Information

- BE90 & BE100 – a section of each on both days. Entries taken on www.bdwp.co.uk/bau on a first received. Times will be posted on the website on Thursday 5th July from 1800hrs.
- If there are sufficient entries, there will be more than one section per height.
- Entries open on 31st May 2018.
- Entries close on 25th June 2018 (if not already full).
- Full refund before closing date. 75% refund after this only if replaced from the wait list.
- This is an unaffiliated event so open to all.
- Entry fee: £40. £5 start fee payable on collection of numbers (contribution to paramedic fee).
- Rosettes 1st to 10th and prizes 1st to 6th in both classes.
- Competitors must be at least in the year of their 12th birthday.
- Horses must be at least 137cm in height to compete in 90cm and at least 142cm in height to compete in 100cm classes.
- Horses must be at least 5 years of age to compete.
- There will be no more than 20 jumping efforts in total.
- XC kit to be worn and body protectors as in accordance with British Eventing rules.
- Tack and saddlery must comply with British Eventing regulations.
- Paper numbers are provided – please bring number bibs.
- Time allowed is twice the optimum time.
- Stop watches are not permitted.
- There will be a drawn order and approximate start times will be given in advance of the day, although the course will only be open for walking before the class starts.
- The winner will be the competitor with the lowest number of penalties. In the event of a tie, the winner will be the one closest to, but under the optimum time with a clear round.
- The Judge's decision is final.
- All riders must abide by the rules, and terms and conditions set out by Barbury International as above.
